

2024 Harrison-Jenkins Memorial Scholarship

Previous Recipient Criteria

1. Applicant must be accepted to a college or trade school.
2. A family member of the Harrison-Jenkins Reunion (A descendent of Lettis Harrison or Rachel Jenkins).
3. Complete the scholarship application.
4. Applicants must provide a current and official letter from the Registrar's Office.
5. Write a 250 - 500 word essay that includes answers to the following essay prompts:
 - Describe how you used the scholarship award in the past.
 - Describe how you did academically last year.
 - Describe your campus involvement. (i.e., club/volunteer/committees/other)
 - How do you intend to use the funds this year?
6. Recipients must use their scholarship award within two (2) years.
7. All Scholarship applicants must include a picture (headshot) with their application for use on the family website.
8. Students awarded a scholarship must give a presentation at the reunion dinner, the year following each award.
9. An applicant may re-apply for additional financial support if they continue in college or a trade school and have a cumulative GPA of:
 - a. 2.5 or better at the end of their first year
 - b. 3.0 or better at the end of their second year
 - c. 3.0 or better at the end of their third year (maximum of 4 awards).

The scholarship payment will be sent directly to the student.

Previous Recipient Qualifications

1. The applicant must file with the Scholarship Committee a completed application form with all required documents as noted in “Criteria” for award of scholarship.
2. The applicant must be a natural or adopted descendant of Lettis Harrison or Rachel Jenkins.
3. The applicant must be a continuing or graduate student.
4. The applicant must be accepted at one or more recognized institutions of higher learning.
5. The scholarship shall be awarded to a student only upon acceptance and continuation for a year to the school chosen. The student must also be committed to completing their certification, license or degree program.
6. The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to verify information submitted with any application.
7. All applicants must have attended the Reunion within the last five years.
8. The Committee and Treasurer shall determine the monetary amount of the scholarship.
